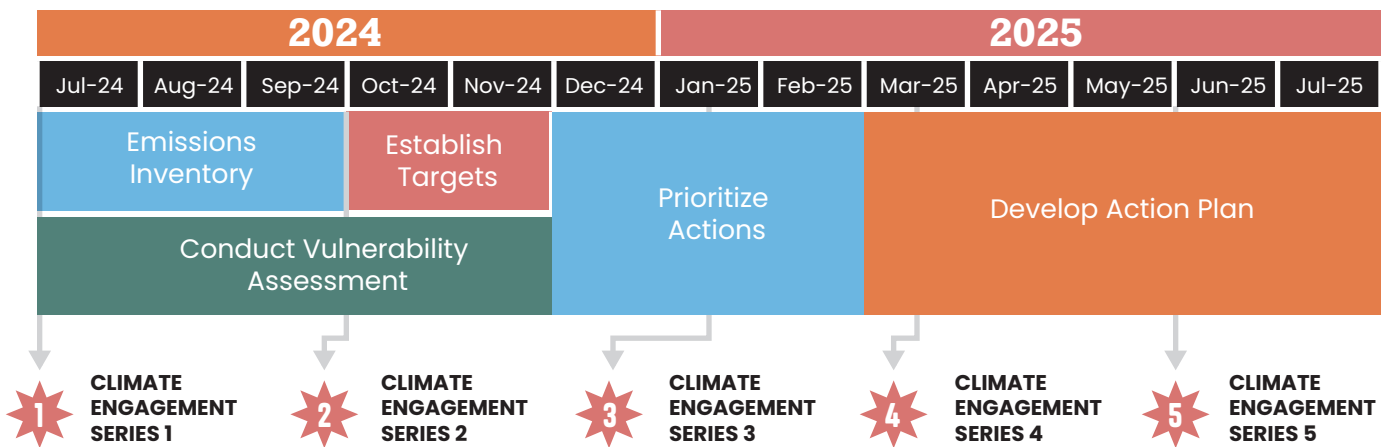

SERIES 1	We are here!
